## Board of Selectmen Work Session Minutes of Meeting April 10, 2014 at 7:30 AM

Present: Chairman, Colin Stubbings; Selectmen, Robert Lang, Ernest Hartley; Executive Assistant, Jennifer Collins; Police Chief Robert Garvin; Emergency Management Director, Bernie Marvin; Terri Mertz; Randy Subjeck; Heather Gates.

Chairman Stubbings called the meeting to order at 7.37 am and stated that it was being recorded for the purpose of accurate minutes only.

The Bagley court hearing scheduled for April 29 at 9am regarding his abatement and his latest email requesting the Town's costs incurred was discussed.

Chairman Stubbings stated he had not finalized last week's work session minutes but they are only due tomorrow. The corrections to the Town Meeting minutes had been made by Town Clerk Bernadette Ratel and these were discussed again. It was noted that the Budget Hearing minutes had still not been done but these were to be available for approval at the Tuesday Board of Selectmen's Meeting.

Selectman Lang stated he had been approached by the Wards regarding the 2012 incident between them and the Andersons and his attendance with Chief Garvin. They are preparing a response to the latest action.

Selectman Hartley stated he had received an email regarding the land for sale by the Town. Selectman Lang said he would raise the draft letters regarding these for the Executive Assistant to type up. A brief discussion was had on the properties and possible future properties that may become available.

Resident Randy Subjeck and his fiancé Heather Gates attended to introduce himself and as a follow up to his resume submission from last year and stated that he was looking for work in Law Enforcement in the area. A general discussion followed.

The pay increase for Wayne Godfrey, Animal Control Officer, was approved. The denial of Veteran's Credit was processed. The petitioned Warrant Article 20 letters were discussed, corrected and signed. These are to be sent certified mail that day.

A summary of those who had expressed interest in the various board's and commission's appointments was made.

Chairman Stubbings stated what had been found in the Town's safety deposit box held at the Piermont Branch of Woodsville Guaranty Savings Bank. Fire safety was discussed and consideration should be made in the discussions on any new potential Town property. The Executive Assistant was requested to raise a letter adding the Selectmen to those who can access the deposit box.

The Work Session relocated to the Police Department to discuss security with Chief Garvin and Bernie Marvin.

At 9.11 Selectman Hartley motioned to adjourn the Board of Selectmen's Work Session, this was seconded by Selectman Lang. The vote passed (3-0).
