Selectboard members present: Chairman Stubbings, Selectman Subjeck and Selectman Mitchell

Chairman Stubbings called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM and apologized for the late start.

Public input only allowed if agreed upon by majority of Board

Discussion regarding switching from Dead River to Jock Oil for fuel at Highway Department

There was a discussion regarding the figures for the truck, financing and wording for the Warrant Article.

There was a discussion regarding the Town Report. The printer from the previous year, RC Brayshaw has submitted a lower quote to do this year's report. Selectman Subjeck made a motion to accept RC Brayshaw's bid for the Town Report. Selectman Mitchell seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed 3-0.

Chairman Stubbings stated he has received notification that we are late in submitting quarterly reporting for employee wages.

Chairman Stubbings read a letter of resignation from Bill Morris for the Planning Board. The letter also mentions an issue with attendance at meetings, which Chairman Stubbings said will be addressed at Town Meeting as a reminder to folks wanting to volunteer to hold positions on town boards.

Lakes Region Mutual Fire Aid Service Agreement was reviewed. The Board was unsure if they had already signed it so to be sure Selectman Subjeck made a motion to sign the agreement. Selectman Mitchell seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed 3-0.

Chairman Stubbings read another letter from Charles Brown regarding the sewer user fees that he does not agree with. Chairman Stubbings stated that he has been looking into it, but hasn't had a lot of time to do so.

Minutes were passed over until the next meeting.
