Subject: Media Release (August)

- On August 3, 2016, Police issued a citation to a resident of Newington, CT for speed on River Road, in Piermont.

- On August 10, 2016, Police responded to a report of a vehicle stopped in the middle of the roadway on Route 25C in Piermont, during the hours of darkness with no lights or hazard flashers activated. It was determined that the alternator to the vehicle malfunctioned which caused the battery to lose power. The vehicle was later towed from the scene.
- On August 13, 2016, Police issued a citation to a resident of Hingham, MA, for speed on Route 25C, in Piermont.
- On August 13, 2016, Police responded to a report of a domestic dispute on Route 25C, in Piermont. It was determined that the dispute was verbal only and the male party had departed the residence before it escalated further. No further action was required.
