Subject: Media Release (February)

February 28, 2017

On February 4, 2017, Police issued a town ordinance violation citation to a Pike, NH, resident for being parked and facing traffic on the wrong side of the road on River Road, in Piermont.

On February 4, 2017, Police issued a town ordinance violation citation to a Kennebunk, ME, resident for illegally parking within an intersection or within 15 feet of an intersection, at the intersection of Sanborn Circle and River Road, in Piermont.

On February 6, 2017, Police took a report of a possible phone scam. The reporting party advised it was an automated call where she was asked a question and replied yes. The reporting party was advised if she felt her accounts were in jeopardy of being accessed, to call her account holders and track any unusual purchases.

On February 8, 2017, Police responded to a reported accident and was stuck in the snow on River Road in Piermont. Upon arrival to the area the vehicle had departed.

On February 8, 2017, Police took a request to conduct a welfare check for a resident in Piermont. Further investigation revealed that person in question was not in Piermont and the call was referred to the correct law enforcement jurisdiction.

On February 21, 2017, Police took a report of a possible phone scam. The reporting party advised she received a call stating she won a lot of money and wanted it verified. After speaking with the caller, it was determined to be a phone scam.

On February 24, 2017, Police conducted a welfare check at a residence in Piermont. The check was conducted and nothing was found to be out of order.

On February 25, 2017, Police took a report of possible child abuse at a residence in Piermont. The matter is under investigation.

On February 25, 2017, Police issued a citation to a Portsmouth, NH, resident for operating an unregistered vehicle on Route 25, in Piermont.

On February 27, 2017, Police took a report of a Piermont juvenile refusing to return home. The juvenile was located and returned to the residence. DCYF was contacted for follow up.

On February 28, 2017, Police took a report of a possible phone scam. The calling party advised her family was informed by a third party that a family member had been arrested and required money for bail. In checking the status of the family member in question, it was determined he was fine and had not been arrested.
