Subject: Media Release (March)

March 31, 2017

On March 2, 2017, Police issued a citation to a Massapequa, NY, resident for excessive speed on Route 25, in Piermont.

On March 8, 2017, Police issued a citation to a Kensington, CT, resident for excessive speed in a school zone on Route 10, in Piermont.

On March 17, 2017, Police issued a citation to a Piermont, NH, resident for operating an uninspected vehicle on Route 25, in Piermont.

On March 23, 2017, Police responded to a residence on Route 25C for a reported domestic dispute. It was reported that a male subject assaulted a female at the residence, but that he was no longer there. Charges are pending.

On March 27, 2017, Police responded to a single motor vehicle accident on Route 25 in Piermont. The driver reported that due to the icy road conditions he lost control of his vehicle causing it to swerve off the roadway and into a tree. No injuries were reported.

On March 27, 2017, Piermont Police arrested Jeremy Lanphear, 47, for simple assault. He was later released on a summons to appear on April 12, 2017, at 8:00 am, at the Haverhill District Court.

On March 28, 2017, Police issued a citation to a Williamstown, VT, resident for excessive speed on Route 25, in Piermont.

On March 29, 2017, Police issued a citation to a Benton, NH, resident for operating an unregistered vehicle on Route 10, in Piermont.

On March 29, 2017, Police took a report of a criminal trespass/prowling from a Piermont resident. The offender was ordered not to go back on the property with a No Trespass Notice.

During the month of March, the Piermont Police Department also took 69 administrative calls, 3 walk-in assists or complaints, conducted follow up investigations, responded to building alarms, medical calls and issued 28 motor vehicle warnings for a variety of violations.
