

BOARD OF SELECTMAN – WORK SESSION

OLD CHURCH BUILDING

THURSDAY JULY 9, 2020

Board members in attendance: Chairman Colin Stubbings, Selectman Wayne Godfrey, Selectman Randy Subject

Members of the Public also in attendance: None

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stubbings at 7:05pm. He stated the meeting was being recorded solely for the purpose of accurate minutes, and that others in the room may also be recording but have not declared the fact.

No public input will be allowed during work sessions unless majority voted by Selectboard.

Wayne Godfrey led the Pledge of Allegiance.

2020 Dog Warrant; No discussion. Selectman Subject made a motion to accept 2020 Dog Warrant. 2nd by Chairman Stubbings. All in favor 2-0-1 Selectman Godfrey abstained (Animal Control Officer)

239 Rt25C Update; Selectman Godfrey stated he has rented an excavator to continue cleanup efforts. Selectman Subject will be volunteering on July 25th (Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day) to load chemicals from the property (239 Rt25C) and bring them to the Transfer Station.

Correspondence; Chairman Stubbings read a letter from Avitar Associates. Stated Mark Stetson (Assessor) will be retiring at the end of 2020. Avitar will assign a new Assessor to us. Chairman Stubbings stated a letter should be drafted thanking him for his time spent as the Assessor for Piermont. Chairman Stubbings read a letter the Town received for the PILT (Payment in Lieu of Taxes) in the amount of \$6,555 to offset loss of taxes collected on nontaxable federal land.

Any Other Business; Selectman Godfrey inquired about flag poles. Selectman Godfrey received a mild electrical discharge at the Transfer Station from a lightning strike at a nearby tree. He will have Will Priestly look to see if the compactor is grounded properly. The Town may need to think about lightning protection. Chairman Stubbings read the monthly reports from the Town Clerk and Tax Collector. Tax payments are coming in steady. Iron Horse Roofing has completed the new roof on the Fire Station. Chairman Stubbings reviewed revenue and expenditure actuals versus budgeted.

Minutes; 06/23/2020; Selectman Godfrey made a motion to accept with changes. 2nd by Chairman Stubbings. All in favor. 2-0-1. Motion passed. Selectman Subject abstained (not in attendance). 06/04/2020; minutes signed. 06/09/2020; minutes signed.

Motion to adjourn made by Selectman Subject, 2nd Selectman Godfrey. All in favor 3-0. Motion passed.
