

BOARD OF SELECTMAN – WORK SESSION

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stubbings at 7:01pm. He stated that meetings are no longer being recorded, however others in the room may be recording but have not declared the fact.

No public input will be allowed during work sessions unless majority voted by Selectboard.

Gary Hebert led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Highway Garage Internet; Selectboard was presented with two options for internet at the Highway Garage. Selectman Subject requested Sandi speak to Charter Communications to see if the Town can get the same pricing it currently has. Tabled until Tuesday.

239 Rt25C; Wayne stated cleanup at the property is just about done, almost ready for raking. Various sized televisions out there still need to be removed. Wayne stated he was looking for volunteers to help Sunday from 12pm-3pm. Selectman Subject and Sean Jones volunteered.

Flag Poles; Bernie will be touring (next week) the cemeteries with Abby Metcalf for placement of the new flag poles. Selectman Subject made a motion to purchase two flag poles along with flags. 2nd by Selectman Godfrey. All in favor. 3-0. Motion passed.

Correspondence; Chairman Stubbings stated the Town received \$10,556.58 from the Highway Block Grant. Chairman Stubbings read an email received from Richard Hambrick inquiring about various Selectboard meetings and has requested a full Town public meeting in August. Chairman Stubbings stated to hold a Town meeting in August it would have to be petitioned in court and require approval from the DRA (Department of Revenue).

Any Other Business; Selectman Subject would like to add mask ordinance discussion to next week's Board of Selectman meeting. Selectman Godfrey stated as long as the discussion was organized. Chairman Stubbings said there will be no vote to be had. Selectboard agreed to add to agenda. Chairman Stubbings read the monthly report from the Town Clerk.

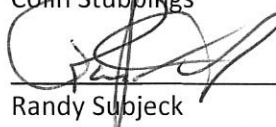

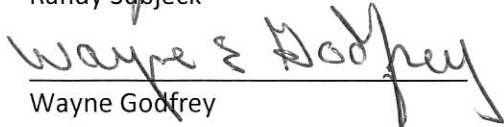
