Highway Quote; Selectman Subject made a motion to accept 200 speed internet without static IP address. 2nd by Selectman Godfrey. All in favor 2-0. Motion passed.

Discussion; Face Mask Ordinance. No new discussion currently. There was never an ordinance to vote on. No document was ever drafted. Audience reinforce overwhelming discern about any face mask mandate.

Wes Chapmon; Wes Chapmon introduced himself as a candidate for District 3 House of Representatives. He briefly read from the NH (New Hampshire) Constitution and asked for Town support.
