TUESDAY DECEMBER 8, 2020

Board members in attendance: Chairman Colin Stubbings, Selectmen Randy Subject and Wayne Godfrey.

Members of the Public also in attendance: Brandon Alling (Police Chief), Frank Rodimon (Road Agent), Bernie Marvin (Emergency Management Director), Heather Subject (Treasurer) Alex Nuti-de Biasi (Journal Opinion)

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stubbings at 7:05 pm. He stated that meetings are no longer being recorded, however others in the room may be recording but have not declared the fact.

Bernie Marvin led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Selectman Subject made a statement in regard to Zoom meetings as follows: He objects to the E format of Board meetings currently, and if people feel the need to protect themselves, they should. Selectman Subject stated it is not true government inclusion. People need to be able to attend, they can social distance at the Old Church Building. Fear mongering is out of control and has to stop. Center for Disease Control (CDC) has unreliable data. Government can never dictate to Americans, only advise. Going Forward Selectman Subject will participate via Zoom from the Old Church Building so that if anyone wants to attend, they can.

Chairman Stubbings read COVID-19 statistics. He stated he has no objection to Selectman Subject opening the Old Church Building to allow the public to attend so long as proper sanitizing is completed. Chairman Stubbings stated we need to keep residents safe.

Bernie Marvin; Bernie attended a vaccine protocol training. Vaccines will be arriving in batches. No date for arrival has been released. Snowstorm this week was well prepared for. Roughly 10 homes lost power in the evening, all were restored overnight. Department of Health and Human Services has been sending out surveys for First Responders in respect to COVID-19 vaccines.

Bernie started the discussion about Arron/Aaron road. He does not do a lot of road name changes. Bernie stated it is spelled Aaron. Frank stated 911 has it spelled as Aaron. All other documents and residents on the road have it spelled Arron. Chairman Stubbings stated the Planning Board should have the correct spelling from when the subdivision and road were approved. Wayne will follow up with Helga Mueller (Planning Board Secretary). Chief Alling contacted Grafton County Dispatch and they have it spelled Aaron with an alias of Arron. Chief Alling will reach out to Hanover Dispatch and request they do the same until it is confirmed what the spelling is.

Frank Rodimon; Snowstorm dropped about 8" of snow outside of the village district. Sand shed for residents has been filled.

Brandon Alling; No accidents during the snowstorm. Rt25C was white out conditions. Brandon stated that when there is a confirmed COVID-19 case in Piermont dispatch is notified of the address in case

Police Officers, EMS, or Fire Fighters have to respond to a call (dispatch will notify responders) therefore following proper safety protocol.

Motion to adjourn made by Selectman Subjeck, 2nd Selectman Godfrey. All in favor 3-0. Motion passed.


