Budget Meeting

Select Board members present: Randy Subject, Colin Stubbings, and Donald Mitchell

Selectman Stubbings started the meeting at 9:05 AM.

Bernie Marvin submitted a proposed EMD budget for 2018. There was a discussion regarding the need to update the Emergency Operations Plan. The update to the Plan will be similar to the Hazard Mitigation Plan; it will be done through MAPS, June Garneau and will be reimbursed through grant funds.

Mr. Marvin is still working on the ambulance coverage for East Piermont. At least one life has been saved due to the quick response by WWAS to the East Piermont area. We really need to continue this additional ambulance service.

The Patriotic budget will remain the same as last year.

John Metcalf discussed his proposed budgets for Recreation, Town Grounds, Cemeteries and Sewer. The swimming pool on Bean Brook Rd may need to be thoroughly cleaned and have increased testing of the water quality.

The Sewer budget will see some changes once a new operator is hired. There will be increases in training, certification and mileage expenses.

Frank Rodimon submitted a proposed budget for the Highway Department. There was a discussion with the Board regarding a few individual line items.

The meeting ended at 12:45 PM.
