

BOARD OF SELECTMAN – WORK SESSION

OLD CHURCH BUILDING

THURSDAY JUNE 20, 2019

Board members in attendance: Chairman Colin Stubbings, Selectman Donald Mitchell. Selectman Subjeck not in attendance.

Members of the Public also in attendance: Wayne Godfrey, Sandi Pierce, Gary Hebert, Frank Rodimon.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stubbings at 7:05pm. He stated the meeting was being recorded solely for the purpose of accurate minutes, and that others in the room may also be recording but have not declared the fact.

No public input will be allowed during work sessions unless majority voted by Selectboard.

Gary Hebert led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Hanover Dispatch; Selectman Subjeck not in attendance therefore item to be tabled until next week. Selectman Mitchell does not have input however stated only takes two. Chairman Stubbings tried to clarify; Selectman Mitchell stated only takes two to vote on it. Selectman Mitchell stated he would make a motion. Chairman Stubbings asked to wait until next Tuesday. Selectman Mitchell agreed to wait. Chairman Stubbings asked Chief Hebert if Randy had his meeting with Tom Andross; Chief Hebert was not aware at this time.

Building Maintenance; To help reduce costs, volunteers have offered to scrape and paint the Town buildings. Happy to accept as a Board, however has to supply paint and all material. Motion to supply the materials made by Selectman Mitchell, 2nd by Chairman Stubbings. All in favor 2-0. Motion passed. Chairman Stubbings will let Peter Labounty know as he is the one coordinating.

Agenda Request; The Selectboard received an agenda request for next week's meeting from Dawn Stygles. Frank Rodimon to speak about it; Culvert just below her driveway, culvert has been there since at least the 70's. Nothing has changed. Last year some of the property was cleared to put in a horse pasture. Now she is complaining as to the culvert is keeping the field wet this year. Frankly everyone's field is wet due to the amount of rain we have received. Dawn approached Frank about this issue he stated he couldn't change the culvert however when he acquired an excavator this summer he would dig a ditch along her property; 150'-200' at the most. That would divert the water along the edge of her property, keeping it from going into her field to help dry it out. That seemed fine. Few weeks ago Dawn approached Frank with the idea that she wanted the culvert removed. There is another culvert roughly 200' down the road that goes across, she wants the water to go down to that culvert and then go across. That may have worked however there is a driveway just before the culvert that was issued a permit not needing a culvert. Removing the culvert at Dawn's will in turn then require the driveway below to need a culvert, and that's not acceptable. Culverts were there first. Chairman Stubbings spoke about the amount of rain we have had in that it is affecting everyone. Frank offered to dig ditch for no cost, now she is on her own to dig a ditch. Culverts have been established along with water easements. Nothing has changed up there not pitch nor grade of the road. Will further discuss at next Tuesday's Meeting. Frank will be in attendance.

Correspondence; Debbie Silverwolf sent in a letter. Chairman Stubbings read letter aloud (attached). States that she had her service dog (Flurrie) stolen from her from a woman named Christa Davis, while she was residing in Maine. Talked in great length about court request being across state lines. No jurisdiction from another state. Chief Hebert clarified his conversation with Debbie in regards to the definition of criminal trespass. Chief Hebert stated Ms. Silverwolf will need to do her due diligence. Chairman Stubbings stated a letter to be drafted by the administrative assistant to Ms. Silverwolf acknowledging the letter, and explain the Selectboard does not get involved with issues outside of Town business. This is a criminal or civil matter. Kelly Sackheim sent an email; Chairman Stubbings read aloud (attached). Chairman Stubbings asked to locate signed agreement between Piermont and Ms. Sackheim. Sandi stated she has not located a signed contract, will continue to search office. Water testing results came in. No PFOA's detected. Actual results are available at Town office. Charter Communications; Upcoming changes, launching a fitness channel to all subscribers.

PILT (Payment in Lieu of Taxes); Federal and State Forest Land, Lake Tarleton State Park & White Mountain National Forest. No discussion. Motion to approve made by Selectman Mitchell, 2nd by Chairman Stubbings. All in favor. Motion passed 2-0.

Intent to Cut; R15-9A Nichols. Intent was read aloud. Frank spoke up and asked about how Mr. Nichols was accessing the lot; Chairman Stubbings stated it was to be from Cross Road. Frank spoke about a conversation he had with a resident concerned that Mr. Nichols would be dragging logs out down the road causing the road to potentially become damaged (class XI). Frank stated he would like to speak with Mr. Nichols as the Town may require a bond in case of any damage to the road. Will table until next week.

Minutes; 06/11/2019; various corrections. Motion to accept with corrections made by Selectman Mitchell, 2nd by Chairman Stubbings. All in favor 2-0. Motion passed. 06/10/2019; Chairman Stubbings still working on minutes; Emergency nonpublic. 06/06/2019; various corrections. Motion to accept with corrections made by Selectman Mitchell, 2nd by Chairman Stubbings. All in favor 2-0. Motion passed. 05/16/2019, still needs corrections. 05/21/2019 was signed.

Non Public Session was entered at 8:10pm citing RSA 91-A:3, II (a & b) after a motion by Selectman Mitchell to enter, 2nd by Chairman Stubbings. Board vote to enter was 2-0 in favor.

Non Public Session was entered at 8:25pm citing RSA 91-A:3, II (a, b & c) after a motion by Selectman Mitchell to enter, 2nd by Chairman Stubbings. Board vote to enter was 2-0 in favor.

Exited Non Public Session and entered Public Session at 8:59pm


Motion to seal minutes made by Selectman Mitchell, 2nd by Chairman Stubbings. All in favor 2-0. Motion passed.


