

BOARD OF SELECTMAN – WORK SESSION

Board members in attendance: Selectman Wayne Godfrey, Selectman Randy Subject.

She would like to start to clean up the yard at the Williams Property. Gary Hebert inquired as to who still owns the property? Was determined that the Town has not taken possession, therefore the Town cannot grant access for a volunteer to go onto someone else's property. Wayne will reach out to Karen and let her know. Any Other Business; Selectman Subject inquired about the Priestley letter. He was pleased Peter Labounty (Capital Improvement Plan Chairman) had met with Will Priestley, however would still like to see it. Sandi has reached out to Peter for a copy of the letter.

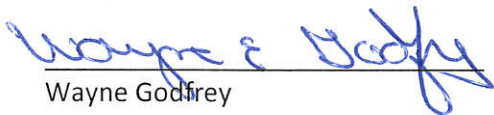
