THURSDAY May 21, 2020

Board members in attendance: Selectman Wayne Godfrey, Selectman Randy Subject, Chairman Colin Stubbings.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stubbings at 7:40pm. Recording for this meeting unavailable, technical difficulties with recorder.

No public input will be allowed during work sessions unless majority voted by Selectboard.

Gary Hebert led the Pledge of Allegiance.

He went with the recommendation from the Town of Orford as there was a cost savings of \$2000.00 overall. He has no timeframe for arrival as shipping has been delayed due to COVID-19. Selectman Godfrey asked Sandi to follow up with Eversource, streetlights still not operating. Selectman Godfrey stated clean up at 239 RT25C has started.


