

BOARD OF SELECTMAN MEETING

OLD CHURCH BUILDING

TUESDAY SEPTEMBER 9, 2020

Board members in attendance: Chairman Colin Stubbings, Selectman Wayne Godfrey, Selectman Randy Subject

Members of the Public also in attendance: Frank Rodimon (Road Agent), Diane Kircher (Deputy Treasurer), Katrina Stokes, Lori Conley, Liana Senoski

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stubbings at 7:00pm. He stated the meeting was being recorded solely for the purpose of accurate minutes, and that others in the room may also be recording but have not declared the fact.

Randy Subject led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Frank Rodimon; Still waiting for the installation of wifi at the highway garage. Finished replacing culverts today. Frank advised the Selectboard he has found a new vendor for purchasing culverts. New vendor is a dollar less per foot. Frank would like to start grading the roads, however with it being so dry he is having to water the roads first to keep the dust down.

Diane Kircher; Nothing new to report.

Wayne Godfrey (Transfer Station Manager); Nothing new to report. Wayne stated he has placed the speed trailer in front of the school to try and slow traffic.

Pool Closing; Set to close September 13, 2020. Selectboard agreed.

Herbicide; Poison Ivy Control; John Metcalf has notified the Selectboard that he would like to treat poison ivy that has grown around the swimming pool and at the landfill gate, following the Town herbicide policy.

Highway Truck Bid Opening; Town received one sealed bid for the 2017 F550 from Phil Blanchard in the amount of \$1501.99. Selectman Subject made a motion to accept. 2nd by Selectman Godfrey. All in favor. 3-0. Motion passed.

Correspondence; Chairman Stubbings read a letter received from CASA for their request for annual donation for 2021 budgeting.

Vendor Manifest; Signed by Selectboard

Public Input; Diane Kircher inquired about the property at 239 Rt25C. She is questioning why the property is not sold. Chairman Stubbings stated it is not a buildable lot. The existing structure that was there was grandfathered in as it is in the village. Lori Conley asked about police coverage while the Town is searching for a new Police Chief. Chairman Stubbings stated there is coverage from the State Police and Grafton County Sherriff. Gary Hebert is still working administrative duties one day a week. Katrina Stokes inquired about the annual report mailing. There may have been some issues with return addresses on the reports. Chairman Stubbings advised her that Sandi is the point of contact.

Any Other Business; Recycling Center security camera quote passed over from last week. Selectman Subject made a motion to accept quote. 2nd by Chairman Stubbings. All in favor. 2-0-1. Motion passed. Selectman Godfrey abstained. NHDES (New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services) Grant form authorizing Wayne to sign for grants. Selectman Subject made a motion to accept. 2nd by Chairman Stubbings. All in favor. 2-0-1. Motion passed. Selectman Godfrey abstained. Intent to Cut submitted by Moeller. U01-004. Selectman Subject made a motion to accept. 2nd by Selectman Godfrey. All in favor. 3-0. Motion passed. Selectman Subject reminded the Selectboard of September 11th "Less we never forget". Flags need to be at half-mast. River Road, South Lawn, Cedar Grove cemeteries and the Fire Station. Selectman Subject has volunteered to lower the flags.

An Adjournment Motion was made by Selectman Subject, 2nd by Selectman Godfrey. All in favor. 3-0. Motion passed.


