

BOARD OF SELECTMAN
OLD CHURCH BUILDING
TUESDAY OCTOBER 13, 2020

Board members in attendance: Chairman Colin Stubbings, Selectmen Randy Subject and Wayne Godfrey.

Members of the Public also in attendance: Trina Stokes, Liana Senoski, Lori Conley, Denny Ruprecht, Ed Rajsteter, Diane Kircher

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stubbings at 7:00 pm. He stated the meeting was being recorded solely for the purpose of accurate minutes, and that others in the room may also be recording but have not declared the fact.

Randy Subject led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Ed Rajsteter; Democratic candidate running for representation in District 15. Introduced Denny Ruprecht who is running in District 2. Ed moved to New Hampshire in 2006 from New Jersey. He is currently heavily involved with the New Hampshire Drug Courts. His platforms are continuing SAU#23 state funding, lowering prescription drug costs, and increase funding for the Meals on Wheels program. Ed's primary focus is education. Selectman Subject asked Ed's stance on the 2nd Amendment. Ed stated he supports enforcement on laws pertaining to the 2nd Amendment. Ed stated he does not support person to person sales of weapons. He feels it should only be left to authorized dealers. Selectman Subject asked Ed to define an assault weapon. Ed was unable to formally define. Ed did state he felt military grade weapons should only be used by those in the military. Selectman Subject reminded Ed he just said he doesn't know what a military grade weapon is. Selectman Subject asked Ed if he supports a ban on the AR-15. Ed stated he does not have enough knowledge to answer the question. Selectman Subject reminded Denny of his previous opposition to conceal carry in the NH House. Selectman Subject asked Denny why he told voters he was pro 2nd Amendment, but then voted against 2a. Ed was asked his opinion on school choice. He states he feels its only viable in certain areas of the State. Ed stated The State of New Hampshire does not have enough oversight to recognize home schooling. Ed thanked all those who attended the meeting for letting him speak. Ed and Denny left the meeting.

Wayne Godfrey (Transfer Station Manager); Freon was removed from the refrigerators. Waste oil grant has been submitted.

Diane Kircher (Deputy Treasurer); Money in the bank. Diane advised the Selectboard of an emergency drill that will be happening two weeks from Friday. In the event of an emergency the kids will be evacuated from the school and walked to the church.

RC Brayshaw Quote; Brayshaw submitted a quote for 300 annual reports. There was a discussion about the mailing permit for the annual reports. Sandi will follow up with the Post Office to ensure proper mailing.

Correspondence; None

Chairman Stubbings to sign payroll manifest after the meeting ended.

Any Other Business; Town Clerk submitted a letter for signatures stating she attended the Primary Election to fulfill her duties as Town Clerk. This letter is needed for her school. Selectboard signed the letter. Chairman Stubbings inquired about the MS434 and the MS535 (these documents are needed to get the tax rate set). Selectboard also signed the letters to the candidates that applied for the Chief's position, thanking them for their interest. Chairman Stubbings stated that it has come to his attention that Veterans' Plaques at the Memorial Garden have been defaced. Chairman Stubbings will visit the garden to take a closer look.

Public Input; Selectman Subject thanked the folks that attended the meeting for attending.

Minutes; 10/08/2020; Selectman Subject made a motion to accept as written, 2nd by Selectman Godfrey. All in favor. 3-0. Motion passed.

Non-Public Session was entered at 7:44 pm citing RSA 91-A:3, II (c) after a motion by Selectman Subject to enter, 2nd by Selectman Godfrey, vote to enter 3-0 in favor.

Exited Non-Public at 8:19 pm.

Motion to seal the minutes of the Non-Public Session was made by Selectman Subject, 2nd by Selectman Godfrey, because it was determined that to divulge the information would affect adversely the reputation of any person other than a member of this board. All in favor 3-0, Motion passed.

Motion to adjourn made by Selectman Subject, 2nd Selectman Godfrey. All in favor 3-0. Motion passed.
