Board members in attendance: Chairman Colin Stubbings, Selectmen Randy Subjeck and Wayne Godfrey.

The meeting was called to order by Selectman Subjeck at 7:00 pm. (Chairman Stubbings arriving late) He stated that meetings are no longer being recorded, however others in the room may be recording but have not declared the fact.

Bernie Marvin led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bernie Marvin; Bernie wished the Marine Corp a happy 240th birthday. Bernie stated there will be Veteran services at Veteran's Park in North Haverhill. Bernie is still working with Dr. Medlicott for a Point of Distribution (POD) for a Covid-19 vaccine. Bernie has been participating in multiple webinars for the Covid-19 possible vaccine. Sandi Pierce; Auditors have been in the office, speaking with department heads going over current practices. Audit is coming along.

Correspondence; Selectman Subjeck read the 2021 appropriation request for both Tri County Action Program and Grafton County Senior Citizens Council. They will be added to the 2021 Warrant Articles.

2020 Property Tax Warrant; Chairman Stubbings read the breakdown of the 2020 tax rate. Selectboard members signed the 2020 Tax Warrant.
