

**BOARD OF SELECTMAN
VIA ZOOM
TUESDAY JANUARY 12, 2021**

Board members in attendance: Chairman Colin Stubbings, Selectmen Randy Subject and Wayne Godfrey.

Members of the Public also in attendance: Brandon Alling (Police Chief), Frank Rodimon (Road Agent), Bernie Marvin (Emergency Management Director)

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stubbings at 7:18 pm. He stated that meetings are no longer being recorded, however others in the room may be recording but have not declared the fact.

Bernie Marvin led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Selectman Subject is at Old Church Building for those that would like to attend in person.

Bernie Marvin; Bernie has been working on coordinating vaccines for folks in Town. First Responders will be vaccinated by mid-February. Bernie is working with Mal Kircher and Dr. Alex Medlicott to set up and execute vaccines for the elderly population in Piermont. There has been a glitch in the vaccine schedule which forced some appointments to be cancelled. The State hopes to have the issue corrected and rescheduled in the morning.

Frank Rodimon; Frank has started working on his Warrant Articles. He has one completed. The one-ton truck has an appointment in Lancaster to have the brakes looked at. The brakes are squishy, however not dangerous at this time. Frank inquired if the Fire Pond on Cape Moonshine Road was active. He has not plowed it this year. Selectman Godfrey stated he did not believe that Fire Pond was active.

Brandon Alling; Brandon reviewed the Police Department statistics for 2020. Cruiser went in for maintenance of a recall on the drive shaft. Ford did not report a crack in the drive shaft however did weld just in case. Brandon has started to transition to paperless at the Police Dept for cost savings. Brandon is working on getting criminal stats to federal agencies for reporting. Brandon has been working on redesigning the patch for the Police Department. Current patch is generic and has the State of New Hampshire seal on it. He would like to make it more personal and use the Town Seal. Brandon presented to the Board three different patch border colors. Yellow, Grey or Blue. Brandon currently has the money in the budget to order patches. He can order 50 patches for \$228.00 or 100 patches for \$282.00. Selectboard agreed they like the yellow border. Selectman Godfrey asked Brandon to get the statistics for the Police Dept for 2020 to Sandi, for placement on the Town website.

Wayne Godfrey (Transfer Station Manager); See attached report*.

Frank spoke about the installation of a water heater in the Old Church Building to operate the sanitizing station that has been installed. Frank inquired if he will be doing it or if the Board wanted to hire a plumber. Selectboard agreed to have Frank install the water heater once it has been ordered and delivered.

Phone System: Selectman Godfrey spoke about the phone system in the office. When Sandi is on the phone messages are going to a voicemail box that is not checked. At this time no one has access to it. There is no call waiting on the phone system. Chairman Stubbings suggested a central phone system.

Correspondence; Chairman Stubbings would like to publicly thank Dr Alex Medicott and Kristi Medill for their generous donation to the Piermont Police Dept. Chairman Stubbings reviewed the dedication page for the 2020 Annual Town Report. This year will be a dual memorial. Selectboard agreed.

Vendor Manifest was signed.

Any Other Business; Selectman Godfrey suggested having the Budget Hearing at the Piermont School Gym to allow for safe social distancing. Selectboard agreed. Sandi will place the notice in the Bridge Weekly.
