Brandon Alling; Brandon has spoken with J&J Auto about installing the brush guard and plastic seating into new cruiser for a cost of \$500.00. Brandon is working with the Piermont Village School to plan more drills with the children.

Travis Daley; Travis has found a new testing company. Also a scoping company has reached out. Cost of scoping is way out of the Town's price point. \$5500.00 for one robotic camera scope to look for sagged lines coming from the store. Travis has found a new epoxy for concrete deterioration. Will order in the Spring. Travis briefly spoke about the reimbursement the Town received for \$6 from Standard Power. Selectman Subject inquired about a quarterly cost savings report. Travis currently stated a cost savings of 25%.
